TECHNICAL EDUCATION - Starting of Polytechnic at Srikakulam during 1961-62 - Orders passed.

R D E R:

Will finalising the Annual Plan for the first year 1961-62 of the Third Five Year Plan of the Technical Education, the Central working Group at Delhi, during the discussions between the Planning Commission and representatives of the State Government, recommended the establishment of a Polytechnic at Srikakulam from the academic year 1961-62. The Government of Andhra Pradesh have accepted the recommendation of the Central Working Group and have included scheme in the State Annual Plan for Technical Education 1961-62.

The Director of Technical Education has submitted detailed proposals for the establishment of the Government Polytechnic at Srikakulam, as a Plan scheme for 1961-62. The Government have considered the proposals submitted by the Director of Technical Education and pass the following orders:

(a) Sanction is accorded to the starting of a Polytechnic at Srikakulam during 1961-62 with an initial intake of 120 students (40 in each of the basic Engineering branches - Civil, Mechanical, and Electrical);

(b) Sanction is also accorded (i) to the incurring of expenditure of Rs.0.50 lakh (Rupees fifty thousands) on staff and contingencies in 1961-62, and (ii) to the incurring of a total non-recurring expenditure of Rs.9.04 lakhs towards the purchase of equipment and furniture during the third five year plan period, the expenditure in this regard being limited to Rs.1.00 lakh (Rupees one lakh only) for 1961-62.

(c) The Government also sanction the incurring of expenditure of Rs.0.50 lakh (Rupees fifty thousands only) towards cost of land for construction of buildings.

(d) The following staff is sanctioned for the period upto 30.6.1962 with immediate effect to attend to the preliminary work for starting the institution in good time, subject to the proviso that the total expenditure on salaries will be limited to the extent of the Budget provision available.

(e) Sanction is also accorded to the staff required for running the first year of the Polytechnic for a period of one year from 1.7.1961 to 30.6.1962 under this Order.

3. The Director of Technical Education is requested to take steps to select a suitable rented building for the location of the institution temporarily and also a suitable site for construction of building in due course.

4. The expenditure mentioned in para 2 above shall be debited to the head of accounts noted below:-

Part II (a) Expenditure of Rs.0.50 lakhs towards the staff and contingencies and Rs.1.00 lakh towards the purchase of equipment and furniture shall be debited "3. Education-D, Special-M. Government Special Schools-S. I.S. 1961-62 in the Third Five Year Plan-XI.B(ii) other Polytechnics".

(b) Rs.0.50 lakh towards construction of buildings etc., to "81. Capital Account of civil works-outside Revenue Account a. original works-(i) Buildings-F. Education-Technical other Divisions 56- Establishment of Polytechnics".

5. The Director of Technical Education is requested to take steps at the appropriate time to realise the central grants on the scheme.
