**Subject: Display of Aadhaar Data in the websites of various colleges -
Against to Aadhaar Act, 2016 - Request for issue of guidelines for
deletion of the same - Reg.**

In the recent past, it has come to the notice of this office that various colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh are displaying Aadhaar data such as name, Aadhaar Number, date of birth, address, bank account details, etc., of the students in the websites maintained by the colleges. The two of such colleges are - Govt Degree College for Women, Srikakulam and Govt Degree College for Women, Ananthapuram.

However, publishing of identity information i.e. Aadhaar number along with demographic information such as name, date of birth, address etc., is in clear contravention of the provisions of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016, more specifically Section 29(2), Section 29(3) and Section 29(4) and constitutes an offence under Sections 37, 40 & 41 punishable with imprisonment upto 3 years.

Accordingly, as per the directions of UIDAI HQs, this office has initiated action and intimated the respective colleges to delete the data from their websites. But, it has come to the notice of this office that the colleges are waiting for directions from the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education to mask / delete the Aadhaar number of students from their websites. Hence, it is requested that the CCE, GoAP may please issue necessary guidelines immediately in this regard.
