This is to bring to the notice of all the Principals of Government, Private, Aided and II Shift Polytechnics in the state of Andhra Pradesh that AICTE – N.E.A.T (National Educational Alliance for Technology) had recently conducted a webinar (an interactive session) dated 22th July 2021 on **“Industry Connect: Opportunities for Institutes to Collaborate with Industries”** to create awareness of the various services facilitated by them to the student community and to the Institutions across India. The following are the three that will be of optimum benefit to our Polytechnics.

1. **Industry Connect:** Internship Portal provides various internship opportunities for students. The registration is free of cost. The portal brings together the internships opportunities in Government sector like MoHUA, NHAI, Railways, MoSJE, MSMEs, Corporate Sector, NGOs, Start-ups as well as Research organizations and these are available on this portal (URL: <https://internship.aicte-india.org>).
3. **Free ELIS:** NEAT Cell also developed a portal called Enhancement in Learning with Improvement In Skills (ELIS) portal (<http://free.aicte-india.org>). A team regularly works on the identification of high-quality EdTech courses which are free of cost. More than 1000 courses are available on this portal.
4. **National Educational Alliance for Technology (NEAT) :** NEAT is a Public-Private partnership model between the Government of India (through its implementing agency AICTE) and the Education Technology Companies of India. AICTE is playing the role of a facilitator between Ed-Tech companies and students/youth thereby enhancing their employability skills, bridging their learning gaps (URL: <https://neat.aicte-india.org>)

In this regard, all the Principals are hereby directed to log into the portals, study the information, disseminate the information and motivate the students to register themselves through the 'Training and Placement Officer' of their respective Polytechnics. Further, the scope of internships in Industry for Industrial training may also be taken up robustly by the Institutions.
