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With reference to the Student's transfers from one Engineering/Pharmacy/Architecture/ MBA/ MCA College to another college within the same University for the academic year 2019-20, the Registrars of the Universities are requested to communicate and instruct the principals of their affiliated professional Institutions to follow the below schedule scrupulously.

Reasons for rejection of applications	Incomplete applications, Over and above the ceiling limit of 1% of sanctioned intake, Unsigned / unauthorized NOCs, NOCs issuedbefore commencement and last Date, Submission of application after last date.

The Registrars of the affiliating Universities are requested to instruct the Principals of their affiliated colleges to guide the students in terms of G.O. ref 1st cited and also not to issue NOCs after the cutoff dates to the students seeking transfers from one college to another college.

Further, the Registrars of the affiliating Universities are also requested to instruct the Principals of their affiliated colleges to effect the transfers of students only after receiving the transfer orders from the competent authority as the aspirant students are facing much hardships by shifting themselves to the new colleges without Government Orders. They may also be informed not to issue Transfer Certificate (T.C) till the transfers are effected. Issuing of NOC by the Principal's does not confer the transfer of students to the new College.

## Guidelines as per G.O.Ns.No:122 Higher Education (EC.2) Department, dated 01.09.2005.:

- Power of transfer of students from one Engineering/Pharmacy/Architecture College to another college at 2<sup>nd</sup>,3rd and 4<sup>th</sup> year be delegated to the Director of Technical Education, A.P., Vijayawada to avoid delay and hardship to the students with certain modification to the existing guidelines.
- No transfers shall be permitted from one University College to another University college.
- Transfer from Private Engineering College to a University College in any region shall not be permitted, because the University colleges if opted by the students not only causes practical problems, but also creates an imbalance in the homogeneity of the learners group.
- Transfer to Regional Engineering Colleges (NITS) shall not be permitted, as the Institutions are exclusive in nature.
- The transfers may be permitted from one affiliated College to another or from a University college to a private (affiliated) college within the same university at the 2<sup>nd</sup> year stage on production of NOCs from both the colleges.
- No transfer can be permitted from one University affiliated private college to another University affiliated private college as all the Universities in the State are not following uniform syllabus and uniform system of examination.
- The total transfers including III & IV year if any should not exceed more than 1% of the total strength of the first year of the college.
- Transfers at III and IV year can be considered under extreme hardship conditions on a case by case, consideration.
- The transferee College may be permitted to fill up the unfilled seats of the previous year by transfer from the colleges affiliated to the same University on production of NOCs form both the colleges.
- The students should be willing to pay the remaining fee for the entire four -year course both to the institution being relinquished and also to the institution to
  which the transfer is sought for incase of obtaining the NOCs.
- The transfer should be only in that branch of Engineering in which the student was studying in the college from where the transfer is sought.
- Bulk Transfers are not permitted unless there is a closure of Institution.
- The applications received from 1st of April of every year till the last date of the month in which examinations are completed at 1st /2nd /3rd year levels shall only be considered and the DTE shall dispose of all the requests received, before commencement of the 2nd /3rd /4th year as the case may be so that the students seeking transfers will not be put to hardship of falling short of attendance for considering transfer applications of students of B.Tech./B.Pharm./B. Arch./Pharma.D/MCA/MBA, Courses in the State

## ORDER:

In the reference 1st read above, the Government issued guidelines in connection with transfer of Engineering students from one College to another at 2nd, 3nd and 4th year levels. According to these guidelines every year student transfer proposals, mainly at 2nd year level and a few cases at 3nd and 4th year level are being received from the Director of Technical Education for Government

It has been noticed that the requests are increasing year after year, mainly due to increase in number of Engineering Colleges every year. As on today there are 253 Engineering Colleges when compared to 57 Engineering Colleges in 1997, when the guidelines were issued last. It is observed that some students are seeking transfer to a better or nearer college in the 2<sup>nd</sup> / 3<sup>nd</sup> / some students are seeking transfer to a better or nearer college in the 2"/3"/4" years within the University jurisdiction. It has also been noticed that such requests are also being received very late i.e., even long after the classes commence. In the light of the foregoing the Director of Technical Edia ation has submitted proposals in the reference 2" read above with a request to stipulate the condition that the applications for seeking transfer from one college to another should be restricted from 1st April of the year till the last date of the month in which examinations are completed.

It is also felt that keeping in view the practical experience in transfer cases till now the guidelines issued in the reference 1st read above need modification to suit the present scenario.

- Accordingly, the Government after careful consideration of the above points and keeping inview of the difficulties faced by the students, while their requests are being processed at Government level decided that the power of transfer of students from one Engineering / Pharmacy / Architecture College to another college at 2nd, 3nd and 4th year be delegated to the Director of Technical Education, A.P., Hyderabad to avoid delay and hardship to the students with certain modifications to the existing guidelines. The following are the fresh guidelines issued for considering transfer applications of students of B.Tech. / B.Pharm. / B.Arch. courses in the State.
  - In case of University Colleges, no transfers shall be permitted from one University College to another University College.

     Transfer from Private Engineering College to a University College in any region shall not be permitted, because the University colleges are opted by the students

- 5) In case of obtaining NOCs from both the institutions the students should be willing to pay the remaining fee for the entire four-year-course both to the institution being relinquished and also to the institution to which the itransfer is sought for.
- 6) The transfer should be only in that branch of Engineering in which the student was studying in the college from where the transfer is sought.
- 7) The applications received from 1<sup>st</sup> of April of every year till the last date of the month in which examinations are completed at 1<sup>st</sup> / 2<sup>nd</sup> / 3<sup>rd</sup> year levels shall only be considered and the DTE shall dispose of all the requests received, before commencement of the 2<sup>nd</sup> / 3<sup>rd</sup> / 4<sup>th</sup> year as the case may be so that the students seeking transfers will not be put to hardship of falling short of attendance.
- 5. The Director of Technical Education shall ensure that the guidelines are communicated to all Technical Institutions in the State for information and take necessary action accordingly for following the above guidelines scrupulously.
