Sub: Technical Education – “Open Defecation Free (ODF)” – Each College adopting minimum 10 Gram Panchayaths - Continuation of Conduction of Survey and uploading of data in Mobile APP – Instructions – Issued – Reg.

As per the instructions of the Hon'ble Chief Minister vide references cited above, 48.0 Lakhs Households information have to be surveyed by the students in the state and 23.0lakhs of toilets are to be constructed and also attention to be focussed on Swachha Andhra Pradesh Mission with particular stress on achieving complete Open Defecation Free (ODF) by 31st Mar'2018. The same has been intimated to all the Principals of Polytechnics in the AP State.

The Special Commissioner of Technical Education has expressed his happiness and congratulated all the Principals and staff for their active participation in the ODF survey conducted at various villages. He further informed that the same zeal and enthusiasm should be extended for some more period by adopting 10 more villages by each Polytechnic.

In this regard, all the Principals of Govt /Private (Aided, Unaided & II shift Polytechnics in Engineering Colleges) Polytechnics are hereby informed to adopt minimum of 10 Gram Pachayaths(GP's) for each Polytechnic and continue the survey by involving all the students (I, II and III year) and all Teaching and non-teaching staff on every Saturday till all beneficiaries in the adopted villages are covered in Swachh Andhra Mission. In this regard, all the Principals are requested to motivate the staff and students to continue the survey and upload the data in the Mobile APP. They are also requested to submit the survey report in the Google format with a link placed in the DTE website “in the other links” immediately on the same date of survey.

All the Principals are further hereby instructed to bestow their special attention in conducting the ODF survey. The Principals are requested to instruct the coordinator to divide all the students in the college into different groups (preferably each group consists of not more than 6 students) and each staff member shall be attached with number of groups basing on the strength of the students and staff.

Some of the Principals have submitted that, they have conducted ODF Survey on Saturdays but it is learnt that, they have not uploaded data in the Mobile app. Hence they are requested to upload the surveyed data in the Mobile APP immediately.

The District Coordinators and the Regional Joint Directors are requested to see that all the Government and Private Polytechnics (Aided, Standalone and II shift Polytechnics in Engineering Colleges) should involve in the ODF programme.

The Regional Joint Directors (AU and SVU) are requested to monitor with the Principals of their Region and the consolidated data is to be sent to the head office by 6.00 PM on the same date of survey.
