**ORDER:**

The Department of Technical Education, AP has taken up major steps to bridge gap the between skills required by the Industries and skills imparted during the study period of the Diploma course. These steps have been taken after deliberations with one of the major stake holders namely the industry. The industry feels that students do not become industry ready without actually understanding the expectations of the industry. Therefore the major step taken is introducing compulsory 'Industrial Training' for six months in the final year of Diploma Course so that the practical applications of theory is better learnt.

The Department has hence, re-structured the Curriculum (C-16) of all the branches to incorporate six months industry attachment of the student to an Industry for training in the final year from academic year 2018 -19 from the month of May 2018 onwards.

In this regard, the Special Commissioner of Technical Education, A.P. Vijayawada is pleased to appoint the Regional Joint Directors as Monitoring Authorities for the respective regions for the successful implementation of Industrial Training for the final Year students of all Diploma Courses from May 2018 onwards. They are hereby requested to take active interest in directing all the Principals of the Government, Private, Aided, and 2<sup>nd</sup> Shift Polytechnics in Engineering Colleges where Diploma courses are being offered to concentrate and obtain the Industrial Training Placements and report the same to the District Coordinating Principals so that all students can be placed in suitable Industries.

**REGIONAL JOINT DIRECTORS OFFICES:**

1. Monitoring the progress with District Coordinating Principals in the respective regions.
2. Attending the Industry Institute Meet conducted at District Level, recording the minutes of the Meetings and sending compliance report to the Special Commissioner of Technical Education, AP.
3. Instructing all the Principals of the Govt. Polytechnics, Private Polytechnics and 2<sup>nd</sup> shift Engg. Colleges where Diploma courses are being offered to obtain Industrial Training Placements for Diploma students scheduled to commence from May 2018 and November 2018 for a period of Six Months each and to submit the data to the respective District Coordinator.



Further, the Special Commissioner of Technical Education, A.P. Vijayawada is pleased to appoint the following as District Coordinating Principals in the respective Districts. The District Coordinating Principal should appoint a TPO from among his/her Staff and the duties are given under:

DISTRICT COORDINATING PRINCIPAL assisted by TRAINING AND PLACEMENT OFFICER

1. Coordinating with HR Managers of Industries
2. Convening a District Level Industry Institute Meet on a date convenient to the Regional Joint

Director, Industry Personnel and Principals of all Polytechnics in their District.

3. Identifying Training Placements in the District and State
4. Collecting and consolidating data received from Principals of other Polytechnics in the District regarding identified training placements by them.
5. Preparing a matrix for deploying students of all Polytechnics in the District in specified semesters to various Industries.
6. Conducting orientation programmes for TPOs of the District regarding Safety, Insurance, Indemnity bonds, Attendance, etc. so as to facilitate conducting of these classes to their students at their respective Polytechnics.
7. Implementing the Industrial Training in coordination with Principals of other Polytechnics in the District.
8. Sending all updated information to respective RJDs with a copy marked to CTE Office and Secretary, SBTET, AP

The Regional Joint Directors of Andhra University and Sri Venkateswara University Regions are requested to contact the District Coordinating Principals in their respective regions and also see that all the Principals of the Govt. Polytechnics, Private Polytechnics and 2<sup>nd</sup> shift Engg. Colleges concentrate on getting maximum number of Industrial Training Placements to enable the District Coordinators to deploy students in either V or VI Semester as the case may be starting from May 2018 onwards.
