Subject: Implementation of the Government Purchase & Price Preference Policy - Grant of benefits to small scale units.

Sir,

Please refer to the Ministry of Small Scale Industries & Agro and Rural Industries (now renamed as Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises) letter No. 21(1)/2000-EP&M dated 28.08.2000 (copy enclosed) providing the following benefits to micro and small enterprises (MSEs) registered with National Small Industries Corporation Limited (NSIC), a Public Sector Undertaking under the administrative control of this Ministry:

- (i) Issues of Tender sets free of cost,
- (ii) Exemption from payment of Earnest money,
- (iii) Waiver of Security Deposit to the Monetary Limit for which the unit is registered, and
- (iv) Price Preference upto 15% to MSEs over the quotation of large scale units.

2. Necessary advice has been issued by this Ministry from time to time towards this direction to extend the above benefits for ensuring marketing support to micro and small enterprises. However, it is brought to the notice of this Ministry that many Government Departments and Government procurement agencies are denying to provide the benefits as contained in the abovementioned Ministry's letter.

3. With the limited financial resources, the micro and small enterprises manage their limited participation at any point of time in the tenders floated by Government Departments / PSUs. Extension of the benefits listed above may supplement their marketing efforts.


4. The Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in its Order dated 12.08.2010 in a WP(C) No. 7704 of 2009 by M/s Delkon Textiles Pvt. Ltd. Vs. Ministry of Railways & Ors. has inter-alia observed that "unless there are good reasons for not extending to duly qualified Small Scale Units (SSU) the benefits under the circular dated 28th August, 2000 by Ministry of Small Scale Industries and Agro and Rural Industries, Govt. of India, which reasons must be recorded in writing, such a qualified SSU should be extended all the benefits, including price preference of 15% over the price quoted by the qualified large scale units in terms of circulars dated 28th August, 2000".

5. It is further informed that NSIC has been rendering valuable marketing support to micro and small enterprises in marketing their products to the various Government Departments. The Ministry of Commerce, Department of Supply vide its circular No. 15 dated 20.05.1996 had defined the status of NSIC as 'Nodal Agency' for participation on behalf of small scale units in various tenders floated by the Government Departments. The MSMED Act also provides NSIC as a 'Supplier' in Clause 2(n), Chapter 1 of MSMED Act, 2006 for participation in tenders for marketing of the products and services of micro and small enterprises.

6. NSIC also makes verification of genuineness of the unit and does a proper assessment in respect of quality of the products manufactured, the capacity of the unit and the financial capability of the unit to execute the purchase order before registering a unit under its Single Point Registration Scheme.

7. It is, therefore, requested that the necessary instructions may kindly be issued to all the offices to extend the benefits mentioned in Government Purchase and Price Preference Policy issued on 28.08.2000 to all micro and small enterprises registered with NSIC. These benefits should also be extended to NSIC as and when they participate as 'Nodal Agency' in the Government tenders on behalf of micro and small enterprises.
