

No. 14 of 1992) came into force after duly approved by the Hon'ble President of the Society (Hon'ble President of India) and communicated by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India Vide their letter No.V.15014/19/2004-MS dated 19th August, 2009. At the State Level the Hon'ble Governor is the President of the State Branch and Collector of the concerned District is the President of the District Branch.

It is also informed that the JRC/Youth Groups in schools/Colleges endeavours to teach students personal health rules, community health and make them to bestow keen interest in people welfare and thereby making them useful citizens. The JRC Conducts training camps in the country and depute abroad on exchange programmes.

The mission of Indian Red Cross Society is to prevent and alleviate suffering of the community. The Indian Red Cross Society shall be guided in its work by the principles of International Humanitarian Law and shall respect the fundamental principles of the Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement namely, Humanity, Impartiality, Neutrality, Independence, Voluntary service, Unity and Universality.

In order to inculcate the principles of Red Cross in children and in youth and to promote the participation of children and youth in the work of the Red Cross and serve the community, it is decided to enrol the children and youth as members.

Therefore, I request you to kindly issue instructions to the concerned for taking necessary action involving the Commissioner of Collegiate Education/ Vice Chancellors of the Universities/Commissioner of Technical Education/Director of Intermediate Education for enrolling the students as members of Youth Red Cross in IRCS.
