All the Principals of Polytechnics (Government, Aided, Private and II shift in Engineering Colleges) in the State were requested to upload the data in AISHE portal vide reference 3rd cited.

But till date only 94 Polytechnics have uploaded the data. Those who have not yet uploaded the data of their Institutions for the year 2018-19 in DCF – III (Data Capture Format – III) on the portal of *aishe.nic.in* are hereby requested to upload before 28.02.2019 without delay and furnish a copy of the same to CTE's office Andhra Pradesh, Vijayawada.

All the Nodal Officers of AISHE who have not yet uploaded their bank account details on the AISHE portal are instructed to will remain open till upload the same before 28-2-2019.

Further, as per the AISHE guidelines if any college fails to upload its data, the Nodal Officer should make arrangement of for collection and uploading of data. The HRD Ministry made it abundantly clear that the Government would be constrained to withhold central grants if uploading of the data on AISHE portal by the institutions is not completed in the stipulated period.

This must be given top priority, as a report is due to be submitted to the A.P. State council of Higher Education and Ministry of Human Resources Development, Govt. of India, New Delhi.

A copy of the reference cited is communicated herewith to the Health, Medical and Family Welfare Dept., and the School Education Department.

2. They are informed that the State Nodal Officer, All India Survey on Higher Education, A.P., in his letter dated: 20.12.2018 has informed that to portray the status of higher education in the country, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, has endeavoured to conduct an annual web-based All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) since 2010-11. For current year, AISHE 2018-19 survey was started and AISHE portal will remain open till 28th February, 2019.

3. University Grants Commission (Furnishing of Information by Universities), Rules 2015 stipulates that ultimate responsibility of timely uploading of the data annually on All India Survey on Higher Education portal in respect of University shall be of the Registrar. AISHE guidelines provide that if any College fails to upload its data, Nodal Officer should make arrangement for collection and uploading of data. The Ministry made it abundantly clear that the Government would be constrained to withhold central grants if uploading of the data on AISHE portal by the institutions is not completed in the stipulated period.

4. The Higher Education Institutions in the State, namely, Colleges and Universities under the control of the Higher Education Department, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada and its affiliated Colleges, under the control of the Health, Medical and Family Welfare Department, Polytechnic Colleges under the control of Commissioner of technical Education, Nursing Colleges under the control of A.P. State Nursing Council & Health, Medical and Family Welfare Department, Teacher Training Institutes under the Control of State Council of Education Research & Training (APSCERT) & the Commissioner of School Education & the School Education Department, Government of A.P.

5. The Health, Medical and Family Welfare Dept., and the School Education Departments are therefore requested to take necessary action for uploading the data and to issue instructions <u>directing the Higher Education Institutions under their control</u> to upload the All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) data for the year 2018-19 without fail.
