All the Principals of Government Polytechnics are informed that there is immense scope for Polytechnics to involve in the testing of materials and in research works pertaining to the Govt/Quasi Govt and Private organisations utilising the machinery and Equipment available in the various laboratories/Workshops including the newly established soil testing lab of Polytechnics by involving the staff and students. Students gain practical knowledge and the Institution will be able to generate income to meet its expenditure for development activities.

The Regional Joint Directors (TE), Tirupathi and Kakinada may be instructed to form a committee with the local Principals and 2 or 3 Heads of Sections (preferably one HoS must be from Civil Engineering Section) to fix the competitive rates to be charged for each test taking into consideration the rates charged by others in the field in that District/State of Andhra Pradesh. The proposals shall be sent to the O/o CTE for approval and further issuance of orders.


In this regard the Principals of Government Polytechnics are instructed to open an account in any nationalised bank in the name of the "IRG-name of the Polytechnic" " for example IRG GPT, Visakhapatnam. This account will be jointly operated by the Principal concerned and the senior most Head of Section who shall coordinate the IRG activities. All IRG transactions shall be made through this account only.

The fee so collected shall be shared in the ratio of 60:40 where 60% of the amount shall be transferred to the "IRG- CTE office" for taking up overall development activities of the department viz., Tech-Fest, journal, digital class rooms, purchase of equipment etc., the balance 40% shall be utilised for making payment, honorarium to the persons involved including students, and the development activities of the institute (30%+10%) or as per the instructions issued by the O/o CTE from time to time. All orders issued earlier pertaining to IRG guidelines of henceforth stand cancelled.
