Excellence in Academic:

The objective of Academic Festival is to identify the best performing Students, Principals, Teachers, Non-Teaching Staff of Polytechnics to recognize and motivate them by giving appreciation awards/certificates.

- **a.** Students secured highest marks: Best outgoing Students who secured highest marks in the End Examinations held in April/ May, 2015 in all branches of Diploma courses in Polytechnics will be awarded. 60 awards for 1st and 2nd toppers of (30) branches will be awarded.
- **b. Student Project Works:** Project works are part of the curriculum at final year Diploma level. A batch of students/individual have to undertake a project work during the course of their Diploma and each lecturer is supposed to design & guide one project work in his/her respective branch to facilitate the students to gain hands on experience in the concerned field. The best project work in each of the following branches shall be selected for award. 1st and 2nd top project works in each of the following branches assuming (5) students for each branch will be awarded.

- c. Best SDCs: The best (3) Skill Development centres (SDCs) will be awarded based on their performance including Number of students trained, Courses offered, Revenue generation, available facilities, etc. <u>03 awards</u>, as decided by the Chief Co-Ordinater, SDC, O/o CTE, A.P., Hyderabad.
- **d. Best Polytechnic:** The 1st and 2nd among Government & Aided Polytechnics, secured highest % of results in all branches of Diploma courses in the End Examinations held in April/ May 2015 will be awarded. The Government & Aided Polytechnics are divided into (2) categories viz., (i) Polytechnics established before the year 2008 and (ii) New Polytechnics established in and after the year 2008. 2 + 2 = 4 awards. Similarly the 1st and 2nd among Private Polytechnics including 2nd shift, secured highest % of results in all branches of Diploma courses in the End Examinations held in April/ May 2015 will be awarded. 2 awards.
- **e. Staff working in Polytechnics:** The Physical Directors, Librarians and Non-Teaching staff working in Government Polytechnics and RJD offices to acknowledge the commitment and to encourage their service to the institution.
