However, it has been noticed that there are still many Government Polytechnics that are not yet registered with a single Professional society relevant to their programs. **Thus, Principals of all Government Polytechnics, irrespective of NBA, are hereby instructed to register their Polytechnics, Staff, and Students with Professional Societies relevant to their programs and actively participate in Society activities.** If necessary, consider establishing local chapters.
