Sub: Technical Education – Rules and Instructions for disposal of motor vehicles on completion of 15 years from the date of initial registration - Instructions – Issued

Ref: Lr. No.: 286/A1/2023, dt: 22.08.2023 of Transport Department, AP

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It is informed that the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways(MORTH), Government of India(GOI) has issued final Notification Vide G.S.R. No. 29(E) dated 16.01.2023 duly amending Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 with regard to Rule 52 of Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 dealing with Renewal of Certificate of Registration of Government vehicles which came in to force on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2023 in respect of motor vehicles owned by Central Government or State Government or Union Territory Administrations; or any Municipal Corporation or Municipality or Panchayat; or a State transport undertaking; or Public sector undertaking; or an autonomous body owned or controlled by the Central Government or the State Government shall expire after the lapse of fifteen years, as provided in sub-section (7) of section 41 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, from the date of initial registration of the vehicle.

It is further informed that if the certificate of registration of Government vehicle is already renewed before lapse of 15 years from the date of initial registration, such certificate shall be treated as cancelled on completion of 15 years from the date of initial registration of the vehicle as per Rule 52A of Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989. However, this rule shall not apply to the Special Purpose Vehicles used for operational purpose for defense of the country and for the maintenance of Law and Order and internal security.

Disposal of above such vehicles shall, after the expiry of the fifteen (15) years from the date of initial registration of the vehicle, be ensured through the Registered Vehicle Scrapping Facility set up in accordance with the Motor Vehicles (Registration and Functions of Vehicle Scrapping Facility) Rules, 2021, as amended from time to time.

It is further informed that MORTH, GOI introduced Motor Vehicles (Registration and Functions of Vehicle Scrapping Facility) Rules, 2021 vide G.S.R. 653(E) dated 23-09-2021 w.e.f 25.09.2021. This scrapping policy intends to phase out old, unfit & polluting vehicles. The vehicles which are not renewable, damaged, beyond repairs, auctioned for scrapping etc., are eligible for scrapping. The procedure for establishment of Registered Vehicle Scrapping Facility (RVSF) and the procedure for scrapping of old and unfit vehicle were laid down in these rules.

Hence the Principals of the Government Polytechnics are requested to send the proposals with details of vehicles in the following table to this office on or before 16.05.2024 to mail ID: [ddt.dteap@gmail.com](mailto:ddt.dteap@gmail.com) and [adtdte2016@gmail.com](mailto:adtdte2016@gmail.com) to accord permission for disposal of motor vehicles on completion of 15 years from the date of initial registration in respect of Motor Vehicles owned by their office through the RVSF unit only and to comply the procedure laid down under the provision of Motor Vehicles (Registration and Function of Vehicles Scrapping Facility) Rules, 2021.
