As per GO RT No 259, dated 25.05.2018 of Planning (VII) Department and GO MS No 62, General Administration (POL B) Department and U.O Note No.1320/Plg VII/2018, dated 25.05.2018, the Government of Andhra Pradesh has decided to observe 4th round “NAVA NIRMAN DEEKSHA (NND)” from 2nd June to 8th June, 2018 and the Hon’ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh will launch the Deeksha with a pledge on 2nd June, 2018 at 9.00AM in Benz Circle, Vijayawada.

As part of the “NAVANIRMANA DEEKSHA” ‘Knowledge State – Employment Generation’ is the subject to be discussed on 6th June, 2018 for debate as given by the Government. The Regional Joint Directors of AU and SVU Regions and all the Principals are hereby instructed to prepare the talking points in each District to highlight the achievement in last four years and the action plan for the next three years in their respective constituencies. They are further instructed to share the same with the respective District Collectors for highlighting the activities of the Department of Technical Education, AP. The Special Commissioner of Technical Education wishes that there is uniformity in the information shared with District Collectors by the Principals.

They are further instructed that to achieve uniformity across the State in all constituencies, for which the talking points may be on the activities such as

1. Curriculum Development with emphasis on mandatory Industrial Training
2. Tech Fest in Polytechnics
3. Establishment of Virtual Class rooms
4. Publishing of Journal of Polytechnics in Andhra Pradesh
5. Providing internet through AP Fiber Grid Connectivity.
6. Implementation of Biometric Attendance for Staff & Students
7. POLYCET – 2018 Campaigning for improving admissions
8. Skill Development through SDCs wherever they are
9. CISCO Academics in Polytechnics/ SEIMENTS LABS in TSDIs
10. Placement details

Action Plan for during the Next 3 Years:

1. Establishing State Institutes of Technology in five Govt. Polytechnics starting six years Integrated B.Tech with Diploma Courses.
2. Paperless administration in all Polytechnics from 2018-2019 onwards
3. Establishing of Digital Classrooms
4. Completion of Course Material for Virtual Classrooms
