# Village Adoption

The following are suggested keeping in view that the most important factor for all education is being able to address the issues troubling society in whatever little manner we possibility can.

Every Polytechnic may adopt a nearby village and extend the services in terms of...

- a) Extending the support of students under the leadership of the Principal and Staff incharge to disseminate information about the benefits to health and hygiene of 'ODF'
- b) (Open Defecation Free) village by distribution of pamphlets, talks to the villagers, etc.
- c) Undertaking minor repairs in terms of plumbing and wiring may also be taken up by giving our man power services (students of CDTP if the institution has the courses) by asking the assisting departments (PR & RWS) to give the necessary tools and utilities required.
- d) Extending the support of NSS volunteers
- e) Extending the support of the NCC wing of the institution.
- f) The students of Civil Engineering Departments may also do their mini projects in the adopted village.

For those Polytechnics that do not have CDTP, NSS, NCC etc, they may consult Panchayat Raj Department and extend their services as required.

The benefits are mutual – the village becomes cleaner and our students develop team skills and their personality. Therefore the Principals may be requested to take utmost interest in this regard. Other suggestions and innovative ideas may be invited from the Principals, staff and students, for undertaking this noble task of making India a clean place to live in.

## **Project Report Preparations**

Student groups may be encouraged to study the various issues that need to be addressed in the village/ society in which they live and prepare mini project reports. They could broadly divide their project work into:

- The problem (issue/s that needs attention)
- The measures to be taken
- The suggested solutions

The success of the entire endeavour solely depends on the leadership and motivation of the Head of the Institution. This is an opportunity to inculcate among our young students a sense of social responsibility, a much needed emotion that all education should be geared to. Therefore the Principals are instructed to take a very active role in this regard.
