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It is informed that as per Curriculum C-20, Diploma students of all Branches are to be sent for Industrial Training for 6 months in their V / VI semesters as per the schedule (spells) already communicated vide circular 2nd cited.

The detailed Guidelines for Industrial Training for 2022-23 are already communicated vide circular 3rd cited to all the Principals of Government and Private Polytechnics with instructions to communicate the guidelines among the stakeholders and to follow them scrupulously.

In this regard, the following instructions are issued to the Heads of Sections of all branches to be personally responsible to look after the following activities at the Institution level for the branches concerned.

- Industry connect: To meet the top-level management representatives of the industry and appraise the need for industry collaboration and also explore the possibility of a tie-up with big Industries and entering into MOUs. Arrangement of industrial visits to students and guest lectures to students by industry experts every semester.
- Industrial Training: Identification of suitable Industries for 6 months industrial training of students in V / VI semesters. Mapping of students and Mentors and monitoring and evaluation of training process. Utmost care should be taken in the identification of industries as effective industrial training is vital in deciding the overall quality of diploma education.

Industries, where there are no activities, commercial training centres established for issuing project work reports and training in Polytechnics / Engineering colleges, should be discouraged.

- Placement of Students: Planning and conduct of placement drives for students at the beginning of 6th semester and submitting compliance report to this office by April of every year in the proforma specified in coordination with TPO of the Institution.
