All the Principals of Government Polytechnics in the State are aware that the Government of Andhra Pradesh has decided to observe 4<sup>th</sup> round "NAVA NIRMANA DEEKSHA (NND)" from 2<sup>nd</sup> June to 8<sup>th</sup> June 2018 and the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh will launch the Deeksha with a pledge on 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2018 at 9.00AM in Benz Circle, Vijayawada.

Further, it is to inform all the Principals that the theme of the programme "**Knowledge State – Employment Generation**" is scheduled on **6<sup>th</sup> June 2018** in which Higher Education is included. So, it is decided to award top (10) rankers of POLYCET, EAMCET and JEE (in total 30) of each district with an Appreciation Certificate and Medal on 06.06.2018 at District level NAVANIRMANA DEEKSHA programme.

Therefore, the Nodal Principals of Government Polytechnics of all the (13) districts listed in the address entry are hereby informed to follow the instructions given below in making the programme successful.

All the Nodal Principals should coordinate with their District Administration in organising the "NAVA NIRMANA DEEKSHA" function on 06.06.2018. They should meet the concerned District Collector on 04.06.2018 itself for planning, guidelines and instructions in coordinating the programme.

The Nodal Principals should contact the top (10) rankers of POLYCET 2018, EAMCET 2018 and JEE 2018 (in total 30) of their district and all necessary steps should be taken in bringing them two hours before to the function for awarding the Certificates & Medals. Parent/guardian may also be invited. Necessary seating arrangements should be made for the Rankers with the coordination of District Administration. Care should be taken in providing drinking water, snacks etc., to the rankers. The list of (10) rankers of each CET, in total (30) rankers should be handed over to the District Collector on 5<sup>th</sup> June 2018 and ensure smooth & effective organisation of the programme including distribution of certificates.

All the (13) Nodal Principals are informed to depute one staff member from their respective Polytechnics to collect the Certificates, Medals and list of toppers from the Secretary, AP State Council for Higher Education (APSCHE), Sree Mahendra Enclave, NRI Block (C-Block), I&II Floors, Opposite State Bank of India, Adjacent to NH-16, Tadepalli, Guntur-522501 on **04.06.2018 at 10.00 AM.**
