Respected Sir,

Government of India is commemorating 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi for a period of two years from 2nd October, 2018 to 2nd October, 2020 at National and International level. There will be a number of commemorative and constructive activities to be taken up by Government of India as well as State Governments. Ministry of Culture is the nodal agency for coordinating all activities.

The National Committee meeting headed by Hon'ble President of India was held on 2.5.2018 and Executive Committee Meeting headed by Hon'ble Prime Minister was held on 18.7.2018 respectively. Suggestions received in these meetings have been shared with concerned Ministries for implementation.

A list of suggested activities is enclosed for your kind consideration. This list is only indicative. The State Governments may take up additional activities at their end. The commemorative activities will continue for a period of 2 years. However, at present, States may draw one year action plan beginning from October, 2018 to October, 2019.

One of the activities suggested is that all tableaux for Republic Day Parade 2019 to be Gandhi themed. Chief Secretaries of States and Union Territories have been advised to highlight Gandhi connect of the State, for example, Bihar on Champaran; Maharashtra on Sewa Gram, Kerala on Vaikom Satyagraha etc.

It is requested that all commemorative programmes may be turned into people's programmes by motivating people at all levels. All activities taken up by the States under the commemoration may also be uploaded on the web portal being hosted by Ministry of Culture.

List of suggested activities for celebration of 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi.

1. Competition of Play on Gandhi-Plays will be organised by schools and colleges across the country. The best team will perform during the International Convention (September 29 – October 2, 2018).
2. Visit of International Convention participants will be organised to Sabarmati Ashram and Dandi Kutir at Ahmedabad, Rajghat, Gandhi Museum and Gandhi Smriti in Delhi.
3. National Dandi Memorial will be completed by 25 January, 2019.
4. Gandhi will be the theme for all activities planned for Republic Day Parade on 26 Jan 2019 including Tableau by various Ministries and states.
5. Special remission to convicts on October 02, 2018, 30 Jan. and 2 October, 2019 and 30 Jan. and 2 October, 2020.
6. Video of "Vaishnava Jana" sung by the prominent singers and celebrities of the country shot at iconic places will be created and screened during the commemoration period. Similarly, another video will be created involving singers of other countries at iconic places of their country. The tune and lyrics of the song will be kept intact and original.
7. Short film competition on Gandhi will be organised.
8. Pada Yatra will be organised involving 150 youth at a time walking for 10 kms per day for 150 days covering every village of the country. Similarly, Cycle Yatra will also be organised. During these yatra, awareness will be generated about Gandhi's teachings, drug abuse and other local social evils like dowry, female foeticide etc.
9. 150 youth/students of one state will visit a partner state under Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat. Camps will be organised for 150 students/youth (5 from each state) for staying together for some time.
10. Efforts will be made to create World record in cycling event across the globe on 29th January, 2019.
11. The Collected Works of Mahatma Gandhi are proposed to be translated into all major world languages and the Digital Library promotion through Indian Embassies.
12. Gandhi parv will be organised at India Gate lawns from 3rd October to 10th October 2018. Kavi Sammelan will be held on 3rd October 2018.

13. Exhibition of books on Gandhi will be organised during Gandhi Parv at India gate lawns.
14. Play "Gandhi & Tagore" by M. K. Raina will be staged during Gandhi Parv. Street plays by school and college children will also be staged during Gandhi Parv.
15. Gandhi Gram will be set up in Gandhi Parv at India Gate lawns.
16. Khadi stall will be set up in Gandhi Parv for promotion of Khadi, handloom and handicrafts.
17. Indian Vegetarian Food Festivals will be organised by Indian Embassies abroad.
18. Gandhi Gram will be set up in Kumbh Mela.
19. Online quiz on Gandhi will be organised.
20. Commemorative postage stamp on Gandhi will be released.
21. Commemorative coin on Gandhi will be released.
22. Logo/Branding will be done in trains, Air India aircrafts and state roadways buses.
23. 150 major Universities of India will tie up with 150 International Universities and organise conferences on Gandhi and bring out compendium.
24. Panchatantra is proposed for inclusion in Value Education Proposal.
25. National campaign on eradication of manual scavenging is proposed to be strengthened.
26. Posters/signage will be installed with message of Mahatma Gandhi on all National Highways and other state roads.
27. Water conservation and restoration of water resources is proposed to be accelerated.
28. Campaign for Swachh Bharat is proposed to be accelerated in a mission mode.
29. Greater emphasis will be laid for Tree Plantation.
30. Campaign against drug addiction is proposed to be accelerated.

31. Dandi Mahotsava will be organised during the period from 02 Oct 18 to 30 March 19 in partnership with Gujarat Tourism Development Corporation, Sabarmati Ashram and Gujarat Vidyapith.
32. Gandhi web portal is proposed to be inaugurated during commemoration period.
33. World Khadi Congress is proposed to be organised in Delhi for 3 days. Best designers on khadi are proposed to be invited from all over the world. Khadi fashion show of 20 top designers will be held during the World Khadi Congress.
